Tim Bays is a speaker, humorist and musical presenter who uses song and stories to entertain and inspire. He has worked with companies from IBM to the General Services Administration and shared concert bills with artists from Sarah Vaughn to Arlo Guthrie. His songs have also appeared in the films "Pink Cadillac" and "Greasewood Flats."
